We recognize that driving is a high-risk activity that can result in fatalities, causing harm to persons, time, property, and the environment.

Therefore, we aim to achieve a motor vehicle accident-free operation, especially at night, with the commitment to :

- 1. Ensuring that every driver meets the driving requirements in accordance with the regulations in the Republic of Indonesia.
- 2. Ensuring that every driver has a company vehicle driving permit approved by the company leadership.
- 3. Ensuring that every driver has received safe driving training from the company.
- 4. Committed to ensuring vehicle inspections are conducted before operation.
- 5. Committed to ensuring pre-trip planning is carried out.
- 6. Committed to recognizing potential hazards to oneself as a driver to ensure safe and focused driving.
- 7. Prohibiting driving for activities that do not adhere to safe driving principles during the journey.
- 8. Committed to ensuring the driver is not under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs while driving and is not in a condition of consuming medications that cause drowsiness.
- 9. Committed to ensuring that drivers traveling at night for work areas more than 30 km must have a travel companion.
- 10. Committed to ensuring that direct supervisor approval must be obtained.
- 11. Committed to ensuring that drivers perform a Stop Work Activity (SWA) if they encounter potential hazards before, during, and after driving the vehicle.
- 12. Committed to ensuring that drivers take a short break if they have been traveling for more than 2 (two) hours.
